



St. Stanislaus School 8th Grade High School Application Process

Students should attend the Open Houses of the high schools to which they will be applying.

Students should arrange a shadow date at each school. The High School Form must be submitted to Mr. Vincent two weeks in advance of each visit.

Students should obtain admissions applications and financial aid information directly from the high schools.

The personal portion of admissions applications are submitted directly to the high school.

Families should follow each high school's procedure for financial aid applications.

The school portion of admissions applications, as well as any requests for recommendations, of all applications for private or selective public high schools must be submitted in paper form to Miss Willis no later than November 10. The release section must be signed prior to submission. These applications require the input of the administration, as well as that of the individual middle school teachers. This makes it a lengthy process. Applications submitted after November 10 cannot be guaranteed to reach the high schools for the first admissions deadline.

Pastor Recommendation Forms must be submitted directly to the pastor of the parish in which you are registered.

The school and pastor forward all completed paperwork directly to the high school.

The High School Entrance Exam for all high schools in the Diocese of Fall River will be administered to all 8th grade students on December 1 at St. Stanislaus School. The results of the tests will be forwarded to each high school that the student indicates on the test day. Since this test will replace the spring standardized testing for grade 8, all students will take the exam whether or not they are applying to Catholic high schools.

When students receive their acceptance letters from any high school, they should notify Miss Willis.
