**Saint of the Week: St. Stanislaus April 11**—He was born in Szczepanów in Poland in about 1036. He studied at Liège, was ordained, and in 1072 became bishop of Kraków. He ruled the church as a good shepherd, gave help to the poor, and performed annual visitations to supervise the clergy. He reproached King Bolesław II for his crimes and vices and at length excommunicated him. Bolesław sought him out, and murdered him as he was celebrating Mass on 8 May 1079.

- **Custom Pages:** Every student gets a one-of-a-kind printed copy of the yearbook, containing two free pages that they can customize with personal photos. If you choose not to customize those 2 pages, they will be general school pages. All customized pages must contain appropriate materials.
- **Buy a Book, Plant a Tree:** TreeRing plants a tree in our school's name whenever someone from our school purchases a yearbook. (And here's a bonus: They print on recycled paper.)

The cost for a yearbook is \$24.94. **The deadline is April 15. After the photo session is complete, your photos will be uploaded to a private custom folder that you are able to share with friends, family and loved ones so that everyone can order prints in many different size options. St. Stanislaus School will receive 5% of the profits from the photo sessions and 100% of the profits from the print sales.

### **2019 Information and Instructions**

- **SCHOLARSHIP** – St. Anne's Credit Union will award (1) \$500 cash scholarship to a Saint Stanislaus School student entering Grades 6, 7, or 8 in the Fall of 2019.
- **STUDENT ELIGIBILITY**- Membership at St. Anne's Credit Union by the student's parent(s)/guardian(s) is required prior to submission of the scholarship application. Board Members and Employees of St. Anne's Credit Union and immediate family members (spouse, parent, child, sibling and their respective spouses or "step" of each) and household members of such employees or Board Members are not eligible.
- **JUDGING CRITERIA**- Scholarship applicants will be judged using the following criteria:
  1. **Essay**
  2. **Academic Performance**
  3. **Community Service**
- Applications are attached.
- **Deadline** for filing is **May 3, 2019**.
- Applications must be typed or clearly printed.
- The completed application must include the following:
  1. **A completed application form.**
  2. **A school transcript or latest report card.**

**3. A short narrative (not to exceed one page) on what you would do to make your community a better place.**
